



### **Hamburg demonstrates an attitude.**

We are concerned about the global development towards isolation and exclusion, religious intolerance, violence, attacks on freedom of the press, minorities, new nationalism and authoritarian behavior, as well as contempt for women.

At the same time, we are encouraged by the many powerful demonstrations especially by women around the globe that have shown: We do not simply accept these developments. We stand up for our values and beliefs, defend the open society and argue for equal rights of women and men.

At the G20 Summit on 7 and 8 July 2017 representatives from the most major nations and international organizations will convene in Hamburg. They discuss answers to key questions of our time.

To solve the problems of the world, we do not need a new nationalism but more cooperation across borders. We should not be instigated against each other, but stand up for a constructive coexistence. We need a modern, democratic and cosmopolitan approach to solving these problems. In this sense we want to send a strong signal:

We stand up for human rights, for a policy of community and peaceful coexistence. We stand up for women's rights and equality, for diversity and tolerance, for respect, an open society and freedom of the press. We stand up for our values and our principles – and for a multicolored world.
